### 2019 – 2020 Programs are Open

- Programs are open for application intake
  - Projects and activities under the program cannot start until April 1, 2019
- Read program guidelines
  - Ensure you know the deadlines
  - Ensure you know your obligations for funding
- Sign and return Letter of Agreement within 60 days
- Call us toll free and talk to a Program Administration officer



### Bee Biosecurity Program

- The objective of the Bee Biosecurity program is improve biosecurity measures by encouraging the use of best management practices
- Pest monitoring and elimination of accumulated pathogens and pesticide residues in wax combs is critical in improving honey bee health
- Application deadline is October 1, 2020.



## Bee Biosecurity Program

#### ► <u>Hive health:</u>

- Replacement of frames & foundations
  - > 75% up to \$3 per frame, max \$5,000
  - ▶ Up to four times # of registered hives

#### Pest monitoring:

- Small hive beetle traps
  - > 75%, up to \$2.25 per trap, max \$2,500
  - ▶ Up to two times # of registered hives
- Varroa mite shakers
  - > 75%, up to \$18/shaker
  - ▶ Up to one shaker per 20 registered hives



### Bee Biosecurity Program

- New this year <u>Disease Monitoring</u>
  - VITA American Foulbrood Diagnostic Test Kit
    - > 75% up to \$15 per kit, max \$2,000
    - ▶ Two test kits per 25 hives registered
- A picture of destroyed frames must be submitted with claim
- ▶ Claim deadline is October 31, 2019

# Advancing Innovative Technologies

- Supports the adoption of new technologies, processes or specialized equipment
- Applications assessed on
  - Level of innovation
  - Degree of industry reach
  - Completeness of application
  - Economic impact
  - Government perspective of risk
- Proposal based with a Letter of Intent
- Yearly funding at 50% of costs to \$20,000



## **Business Advisory Services**

- Consultation services for types of business planning needs
  - business; marketing, feasibility
  - succession, food safety, farm safety
- 50% cost share up to \$10,000
- Funding for one type of plan once
  - exception for feasibility and marketing



### Market Expansion and Export Readiness

- Proposal based with a Letter of Intent
- Objective is to access new markets or expand markets both domestically and internationally
- > Yearly funding at 50% of costs up to \$50,000
- Maximum of \$150,000 over CAP



## Missions and Investigative Travel

- Travel to develop a new market or investigate new technology
  - approvals based on business case
  - one trip per year
- Lump-sum payment depending on destination (one person only)
- Claim based on proof of travel, not invoices and proof of payment
  - plane ticket or hotel receipt with dates



## Soil and Water Sustainability

- Objective is to mitigate the environmental risk to farm operations
- Limited funding, approvals are risk based
- All projects will be funded at 25% of costs to the applicant's maximum
- Applicant's maximum funding is 10% of gross commodity sales to a maximum of \$15,000



# Technologies for Value-Added Agriculture

- Objective is to support plant modernization activities by
  - Enhancing efficiency or productivity
  - Installing energy efficient systems & technology
- Proposal based with a Letter of Intent
- Yearly funding at 50% of costs up to \$50,000/year
  - ▶ \$150,000 over CAP



#### Small Farm Acceleration

- Support small farms as they grow into viable commercial operations
  - If growth targets not met, may not be funded for next year
- > Open to farms with farm income up to \$60,000
  - ► Farms with income between \$30,000 and \$60,000 must relinquish eligibility to other programs
- Can choose to stay in program until reach \$100,000 of income or end of CAP



#### Small Farm Acceleration

#### PHASE 1

- Complete business plan (50% assistance up to \$2,500 available to hire a consultant or \$1,250 to do your own)
- Complete farm growth action plan
- Complete "Grow Your Farm Profit" online workshop

#### PHASE 2

- Stream 1- loan interest rebate up to \$5,000/year
  - one loan/program year
  - any financial institution/equipment dealer
- Stream 2- project grants
  - ▶ 50% assistance up to \$5,000/year, \$25,000 over CAP
- Stream 3- business advisory services (consultant services)
  - ▶ 50% assistance up to \$2,500/year
