


Delayed Spring


- Cold open winter (2019)
 - Lots of icing in the fields
 - Caused wide spread winter injury
 - Also allowed for deep frost
 - The deep frost combined with the cold May delayed development




Monilinia

- Delayed and extended period of susceptibility
- Multiple infection periods
- Some fields required two application to have adequate control
- Severe infections in many places











Warmer June

- Bloom was delayed
 - Warmer temperatures did not result in plant development catching up
 - One of the best pollination seasons in recent memory
- Leaf feeding insects hit post bloom in many areas
- First blue wasn't noted until mid July
- Hot and dry July
 - Sporadic and isolated rains



Blueberry Maggot

- Very late captures
 - Middle to end of July
 - Still getting first captures the first of August
- Delayed emergence may have resulted in some growers missing the application timing



Harvest

- The bulk of harvest started around the 18th
 - Much later than normal
 - From a crop development standpoint
 - Earlier than should have
- Still noting green and under ripe fruit in harvested crop well into the first week of September.
- The crop never "caught up"






- Very sporadic yields
- Many areas were below average to poor.
 - Some fields came off better than anticipated
- Some areas that had snow cover and/or didn't have a lot of frost injury last year faired well.
 - There were some good yields around the province. (5000-6000 lbs/acre)

Price and Cashflow

- Field Price \$0.45/lb in 2019
 - 10 year average \$0.537/lb
 - 5 year average \$0.39/lb
- Farms are still struggling after years of low cashflow





- Plants went into winter well.
- Generally speaking the winter has been easy on the crop
- Crop potential looks decent
- The general trend looks positive
- Weed control is still going to be an issue
 - Lots of fescue impact yields and harvest ability
